45 and the whole purpose of this is to showcase what our youth are
46 doing. In fact, later on today I have a conversation with some
47 young people who want to get involved in what -- everything that's
48 going on, have real conversations.

49
50 So I think it's important that we stimulate our youth and we engage
51 them in every way we can and I've been trying to do that since I
52 started working with the County and I know many of you have been
53 doing that as well. And Legislator Cilmi and I have a
54 shared-intern who is doing great work, so -- and I know he knows
55 who I'm talking about. But I think it's important that we
56 definitely do more outreach to our youth and I think this is a step

1 in the right direction.
