- Leg Flotteron discussed why the Task Force was started and asked to go around and ask everyone their thoughts on what the current Police Headquarters needs and thoughts on a new building
 - Commissioner Hart- The Police administration thinks that refurbishment of the current building is probably more cost effective
 - Chief Cameron-
 - Bathrooms at HQ are scheduled to be redone and some have already been done
 - There is currently a lobby security upgrade scheduled
 - External Fingerprint lab is still waiting on funding
 - Parking lot was just redone and Police museum is scheduled to be refurbished

- Renovating and moving fingerprint lab would expand command space by 10,000 sq ft
- IAB files are not all kept in department due to space
- Frank Matthews-
 - Points of access for power lines need to be reviewed
 - Uninterrupted Power Supply is currently budgeted
- Darnell Tyson-
 - New building would have to be at least the same size (130,000 sq ft)
 - Current building may not be totally ADA compliant
 - Possible cost of new building could be approximately \$600/sq ft – could be up to \$100M
 - He will need 1 month to review and calculate costs of renovations vs new building
- Lance Reinheimer-
 - Construction costs for security would exceed building a regular office building
 - Police HQ lends support to the East End Police Departments
