- 1:00pm Meeting was called to order
- Introduction of all in attendance
- Minutes of March 13 building tour were approved
 - Motion by Lance Reinheimer-Second by Commissioner Hart
- DPW Presentation-Paul Clinton, James Ingenito
 - These are budgets, not estimates
 - Legislator Hahn has concerns over creating new issues with a renovation to an old structure (roof, HVAC)
 - Gerry Andreus noted that if a new building was built, that the old building could be used for file storage
 - He would have to talk to a broker to find out building's value with the current market's uncertainties
 - Eric Hoffmeister noted that if a new building was to be built, a market analysis would have to be done to see where the best place to build the new building would be
 - Legislator Hahn asked that individual security aspects of a new building be identified (underground parking lot, wifi security, bulletproof windows)
 - Legislator Flotteron asked for more specifics of the components of options 3&4 including why there is an extra 100,000 sq ft in options 3&4

- DPW agreed to come back with a more specific breakdown of the building increase in square footage
- Chief Cameron asked that the task force agree that Property Bureau, K9 facility, and ID Lab should be the immediate project
- Lance Reinheimer stated that bonding for the \$16M needed for the ID Lab, K9 Facility, and Property Bureau would best be done now for interest rate purposes
- Legislator Flotteron asked that Chief Cameron and Commissioner Hart create a wish list ranked in order of importance
- The Task Force unanimously agreed that the 3 units needing immediate upgrades should move forward immediately
