PROCLAMATION 2021-09

PROCLAMATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY
UNDER SECTION 24 OF ARTICLE 2-B OF THE EXECUTIVE LAW

A State of Emergency is hereby proclaimed in Suffolk County, New York, for a period of time beginning at Twelve o'clock. on August 21, 2021 and continuing in effect for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days.

The State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions produce by Tropical Storm Henri. Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety of the citizens of the County of Suffolk.

As Chief Executive of Suffolk County, I, Steve Bellone, have exercised the authority given to me under New York State Executive Law, Article 2-B, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the community.

I hereby direct all Suffolk County Departments, Agencies, and Divisions take whatever steps are necessary to protect life and property, and public infrastructure, and to perform other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
