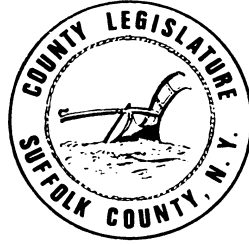

Please be advised that **The Suffolk County Review Committee for County Siting of Memorials and Symbols and Naming of County Facilities, Parks, and Roads** will meet **Monday June 13, 2022 at 12:00 pm**. The meeting will be conducted as a hybrid of **ZOOM** and in-person. **ZOOM** information will follow for those committee members opting to participate remotely.

The meeting will be held at the **William H Rogers Building, 725 Veterans Memorial Highway, Smithtown, NY, 11787**. The legislature has resumed in-person public attendance, and in-person public portion comment at legislative meetings.

In accordance with county and state COVID-19 safety protocols, members of the public who wish to enter the building will undergo temperature checks. Visitors who are vaccinated against COVID-19 and who are willing to provide proof of vaccination, if requested, will not be required to wear a mask while inside the building. Those who are not vaccinated or who do not wish to disclose their vaccination status will be required to wear a mask at all times while inside the building. Inside the Rose Caracappa Auditorium, there will be designated seating areas for vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals.
